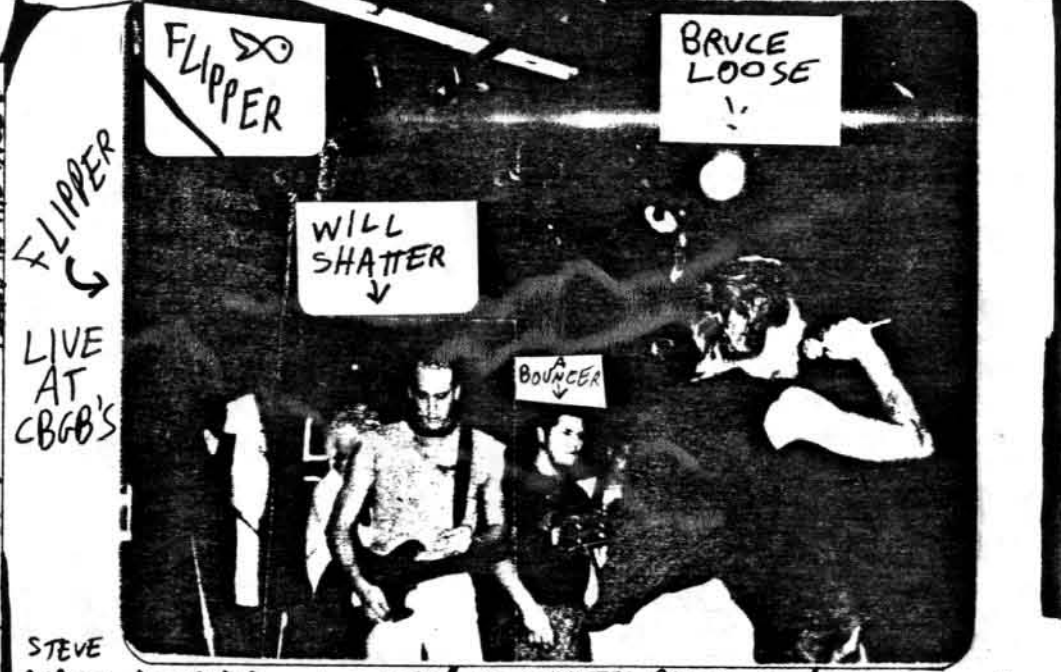

FROM NY WE SPOKE TO ROGER AND
VINNIE NUMEROUS TIMES IN JANUARY
AND FEBRUARY, ABOUT SKINS, MAX R & R, THE
NEW RECORD, ETC. READ ON...

BSM: How long has A.F. been a band?
Vin: 2 1/2 Years.
BSM: And you've had a lot of members
leave...
Vin: Yeah, I'm the only original member.
It wasn't my band but I started it.
When we started, I was the only musici-
-an. The other guys didn't play, they
only hung out.
BSM: Are You Happy With the New Album?
Vin: Of course, you always progress. I'm
always happier at the newer stuff. We
just got off an east coast tour (Jan).
BSM: We haven't seen any money off it.
We had a verbal agreement with John
Loden (of Rat Cage records), and we
thought that was OK. Never signed any
contracts. We're going on tour on Mar
27, and it's not been promoted. The
album wasn't promoted. No college sta-
tions have it or nothing.
BSM: So You Got Pipped Off?
BSM: We were supposed to get paid in
Sept, but.... Some people are complain-
ing that it's \$10, it was supposed to
be \$5!
BSM: Is there a good reaction to your
music?
Vin: Yeah, we don't get no negative reac-
tion to our stuff. We don't see any
gangs or gang violence.
BSM: You guys say you're pro-America &
will defend it. Are you in the army?
BSM: No, we'll fight if we have to. The
whole band is anti-war. We'll fight to
survive, we won't back up and die. We
love the country, not the government.
BSM: Are you a Political Band?
BSM: Anti-war, Anti-government. We try
stick to street politics. "Time Will
Come" is our only political song, and
it's not on any album. We're not real-
ly into world politics.
BSM: We're not too political. Hey, we
have our beliefs. Our first song was
song of pride. The second was anti-
nazi.... People say we're nazis and
fascists!
BSM: Well, are you nazis & fascists?
BSM: No, we're not. I do believe some fa-
scism works, some socialism. People
are into anarchy, so it's trendy. I'm
a liberal, into a little bit of every-
thing. I see good and bad in everyth-
ing.
BSM: Have you ever had police problems?
BSM: No.... We've been arrested, y'know,
but the cops.... We have cop friends.
There are good cops and bad cops, we
have nothing against them. We lie to

them and say we're in the army!
BSM: How is a skin band different from
hardcore?
BSM: Maximum Rock & Roll created the
Skin/Punk problem. There was none, and
now everyone's paranoid. Tim Yo has a
power trip. I'm going to California,
soon, so he better watch out. There's
no difference.
BSM: What do you think about the scene?
BSM: Our first major tour is in March.
Connecticut is a small scene, but we
got a good reception. Virginia has a
nice following. Boston, I don't reme-
ber. In California, the A. front is
there.
BSM: Who do you guys like?
BSM: I like Warzone, 10-song EP out soon. Shows
a heavy noise, thrash band-original sounding
good thrash.
BSM: I like Psychos and Murphy's Law.
BSM: Do You Have A message to your fans?
BSM: Well, our message is that, just be proud
of yourself, don't bother anyone. Stand
alongside each other, help each other.

Record Review - Sticism

FROM THE MINUTE YOU SEE THE DOCTOR & NURSE ON THE PICTURE SLEEVE AND THE FREE POSTER AND THE LYRIC BOOK, YOU CAN TELL THAT YOU'RE GETTING A QUALITY PRODUCT.
