Like "Rights of The Accused" (see Issues #3, 4) and "Naked Raygun", Articles of Faith help make up the Chicago scene. They have been together for 3 years, have 2 7" EPs out, and an album "Give Thanks", that is in record stores now. The Current Line up is: Dave - Guitar, Dorian - Guitar, Joe - Bass, Virus X - Drums, and Vic - Vocals, Guitar.

BSM: How is the scene in Chicago?

Vix: It could be better. There's one club, some good bands - Naked Raygun.

BSM: Do you play live often? Do you get a good reception to your music?

Dave: Yeah - Our reputation is from playing live.

Dor: No one has our records.

Dave: They're all sold out but no one has them.

BSM: Do you have any problems with police or gangs?

Vix: No, not really. The band? Do I personally have problems? I do. I don't care for them.

Dave: Where would be without them?

BSM: Are you going on tour?

Vix: No, just weekend tours, and they don't count. They're too short.

Dor: We're going out soon, but the album...

BSM: Are you having Distribution Problems?

Dor: No one has it!

Vix: No Comment. It's getting out slowly but surely. They should demand lyric sheets. You don't have to write this all out.

BSM: Any future recording?

Vix: Soon, in a few months.

Dave: We're going to be working on a 8-song mini-LP, we're recording in Minneapolis in a little while.

BSM: Are you a political band?

Vix: I wouldn't say we are. Everytime you get a song, it's going to say something. I'm a revolutionary Communist...

Dave: We're a pseudo-pop-metal-core...

band. It's the only way to describe it.

Vix: I disagree.

(Dave & Vix continue disagreeing each other for a few minutes)

Vix: I don't think any of us write to educate anyone in our music. That's how politics emerge. On the album - songs "5 o'clock" and "American Dreams" are very symbolic & abnormal. I wrote "Give Thanks".

Dave and Vix wrote most of the music & lyrics. Joe wrote a song. I wrote a couple - Things get shifted and changed. The end product is different.

BSM: How do you like New York?

Vix: I had to rush through a Chinese dinner before the show. I hate it. Nuke New York! Anti-NY!

Live: Being a Five-piece, the band is very powerful live. Especially when vocalist Vix plays guitar also and it creates a massive wall of sound that is incredible. They performed a large number of tracks from their new album, including "5 o'clock", "American Dream", "In This Life" and others. The crowd was receptive to their music, although the amount of slamming wasn't really tremendous in comparison to other shows. They got called back for a well-deserved encore, and did a long but great number called "Prostitute". The crowd loved it. Although the stage was small, the band jumped and played very energetically. For some reason, Corrosion of Conformity received a better reception, though. C.O.C. is also interviewed in here or in next issue or something...

Record Review - GAY COWBOYS IN BONDAGE MY "OWEN MARSHMALLOW STRIKES AGAIN" 7" Wow. THIS IS REALLY COOL. NO, it's not hardcore, but it has some hardcore influences. The guitar is mixed really low, but it's very rhythmic and sing-along choruses. "Funny Red Mustache (of Kool-Aid)™" has to be the best song on the record. It's soooooo funny, and it tries to be serious. The snare drum and vocals are way too loud, though. The producer should be shot. Anyway, "More Bruises" is anti-child abuse, but it's really bad musically and vocally. "First May Follow" is faster and goofier. (sic) "Big Fat Baloney Sandwich" is a serious song, believe it or not. BSM: Are you happy with the success of your band?

Marc H: What success?

Henry: I guess, sort of. I don't make any money. The last company (BYO) didn't pay us at all!

BSM: I saw a flyer for a CBGB's matinee with your name on it.

Bob: Yeah, we had a dumb promoter, he didn't tell anyone that we cancelled.

BSM: Who are your musical influences?

Marc H: Elvis Presley!

BSM (laughs): Wasn't he an old fart who couldn't fit into his clothes?

Marc H: (laughs) Before that... When he first started he was a real rebel.

BSM: But he sold out.

Marc H: Yeah.

BSM: What do you guys do for fun?

Bob: We all skate.

BSM: Are you a skate band?

Bob: We have some songs about skating, and we all skate. I don't know if that makes us a skate band.

Marc: I like science fiction movies. Did you ever see "Bambi meets Godzilla"?

BSM: (laughs) Yeah, it was great.

NEVER MORE ARE A NEW YORK BAND (NO JOKE?), AND THEY ARE REALLY RAD. SEEING THEM LIVE IS LIKE WATCHING "S*W*A*T MEETS DAWN OF THE DEAD", AND THAT'S A COMPLIMENT. IN THE LAST



FEW MONTHS I'VE SEEN THEM SEVERAL TIMES, SO I CAN CONSIDER MYSELF A RELIABLE SOURCE ON THEIR MUSIC. THEY COME ACROSS AS A MIXTURE OF IRON, MAIDEN, BLACK FLAG, CIRCLE JERKS AND LEEWAY. ALTHOUGH MOST OF THE SONGS DON'T HAVE SOLOS, THEY HAVE A DEFINATE METAL FEELING TO THEIR SOUND, (ESPECIALLY WITH THE NEW DRUMMER, MIKE).

"Shock Tactics" is a good song by them, in which vocalist MATT changes the lyrics when he feels like it, or the music, depending on how the band feels. AT THE MARCH 16TH SHOW AT CBGB'S, HE CHANGED THE MUSIC. WHY NOT. IT SOUNDED BETTER, TOO. "HALLUCINATIONS" HAS A HEFTY INSTRUMENTAL INTRO, AND FEATURES LYRICS THAT GO AGAINST THE MUSIC. GUITARIST KENNY REALLY SHOWS HIS STUFF ON THAT ONE.
