A lot has been happening in the Hardcore scene. Besides CBGB's, the Rock Hotel has been attracting such name bands as the Exploited, UK Subs and the Dead Kennedys. There are also many smaller clubs, like Plugg (140 W. 24th St.) and No-Se-No (40 Livingston St.) that focus on local bands, such as: the Cromags, Sacrilege, and Armed Citizens. Most New York bands have T-shirts for \$4-\$6 and stickers for free. A good place to see some bands and hang out is the Subway, which is, believe it or not, in a subway (63rd Drive, Rego Park). They play good music to dance to (hardcore and punk) as does Danceteria, which is only \$3 most weeknights.

A good radio program is on WSAI, 88.85, Thursday, 10-2, but is located in Staten Island and easier to reach from Manhattan. Now we have to be content with measly "Hell-hole," which isn't the most exciting thing in the world, and is only one hour long.

There are a lot of good fanzines around, as well. *Crashing Waves*, which deals with other types of music also is working on its third issue. *Heaven Down Here*, #3 is available for 50¢ at 99 records at 99 MacDougal St. in the Village. It's larger and has nice pictures. *Guillotine #9* should be out soon, but is gigantic, so takes a while. My own *BSM* should be out in a short time, and you can buy it directly through me. *Bleecker Bob's* Records carries all fanzines and all the newest records. Well, that's all for now. Mike Riot....

May 17, 1995

What a night. I got to CBGB's around 10 or so & watched Damage & UKSUBS play great sets. Then the Exploited.... Wattie started the evening in an interesting way (he sprayed the UKSubs drummer with a fire extinguisher!). Then they went on. Wow. The band alternated between playing all their favorites, like 'Barmy Army', 'Punks Not Dead', 'sex & Violence' & many more, and spitting beer at the audience, which is fun in it's own way. Wattie's comments onstage were interesting (anti-Queen, MRR, war, etc). I hung out backstage and sput beer with them also. (I'm straitedge, don't drink) I found out that Wattie is not the Wanker that everyone says he is. It's really interesting backstage. Drummer Willie comparing army knives with some bystander, Bassist Karl looking for beer, Guitarist Wayne complaining how he couldn't hear himself onstage, Wattie looking for Schnaps.....

BSM: Do you guys like the US?

NO REMORSE

No Remorse are a really rad Band from New Jersey. They've been

together for about 4 months. They had their first show March 3rd at CBGB's with Agnostic Front and the Psychos, their 2nd show also at CBGB's with the Cro-mags + Violent Children, and their most recent show at the Rainbow Club in Passaic, NJ - May 18 - with the Cro-mags + Malignant Tumor + 2 others. Now they're trying to a record a demo tape. "We're trying to find which place is best," says Vocalist Samie, 16. Although they don't really get into the New Jersey scene, they say they relate more to the scene in New York, "We're really into the NY scene, Agnostic Front + Cro-mags". How about Jersey? "It's alright. It's not shitty like people say it is," quoted drummer Henry, 14. They play Cro-mags type hardcore with down to earth lyrics in songs like "Backstabber", "Misunderstood" and "Zero Mortality". They aren't a skinhead band. They describe themselves as "just regular, like the Mob." Are they trying to say anything to anyone in their music? "Not really. We just write about our experiences. We have this song called 'Fake Friends'. We don't write about the government 'cos we don't know anything about it," admits Janie. Live, the band comes across very powerfully, but should move around a little more onstage. Guitarist Mike, 15, bashes away power chords and leads like no one I've seen in a while, and bassist Jim, 16, fits in a perfect rhythmic blend with Henry. I was too busy moshing and having a fun time to write a full live report about them, but if you wish to call them and offer support or book a show with them, I think Jim's # is: 201-869-6216. Good luck in the futures, dudes. You're really rad. **NO REMORSE** You rule.

AD The World - April 27

Well, I got to the show really early and it wasn't crowded so I bought a T-shirt & waited. ANTIDAM sucked. Next were FALSE PROPHETS, and they gave an excellent set, of course. They played "Banana Split Republic (off the Peace comp)", "I Am The Taxidermist" (off NY thrash comp), + many more of their favorites. They are definitely one of the more talented NY bands around today. "Rhesus Monkey", a new song, is really rad! Vocalist Stephan was his usual self onstage. Even better than their last show at CBGB's. Next were LIVE SKULL, and they were almost as bad as Antidam. THE BUTTHOLE SURFERS were the next band on, and I'm afraid I have to eat every word I said in the bad review I gave them in issue #4. They ripped! The lead singer came out in a dress, used a bull-horn into the mic, had fake blood all over himself, stood on chairs, ripped off his clothes and actually sang sometimes, too! They had two hyper-active drummers and a bass player who doubled on Tuba! The guitarist kept up a blistering pace. The music was rhythm oriented noise, and I found it interesting, though repetitive. Then the DEAD KENNEDY'S came out. Jello was dressed in a funny plastic jacket and striped pajamas. They played about 7 new songs, including "Dear Abby" + "MTV Get Off the Air", plus some of the old favorites including "Chemical Warfare", "Your Emotions", "I Kill Children" (dedicated by Jello to the NYPD + their stun guns), "Nazi Punks Fuck Off" (dedicated to a guy who started a fight there) + "We've got a Bigger Problem Now", which was played on the second encore. One or two off the last album, as well. They were pretty tight, but some of the new songs are not as incredible as their other stuff. No one was slamming really until the end. Bummer. Jello was bitching about the 2 fights + hardcore in general + I had a good time, but when you see them live, you realize they are only people, too. "...the blind lead the blind..." Jello Biafra
