With the remaining members of the DAMNED moving onto Grimely Fiendishes & other stuff, we had a chance to talk to ALGY WARD, now a member of **TANK!** which is heavy metal, but still pretty good. They have an album out on Roadster Records/Important, called "Honour & Blood". The Interview was done by Mike Bullshit & some unknown bystander, who we think is from a radio station.

BSM: What's Tank up to now?

ALGY: We have a June Tour with Motorhead.

Bystander: Have you seen 'fast Eddie'?

ALGY: I haven't seen him in like 6 months. I saw Lemmy a few weeks ago.

BSM: Are you thinking about video?

ALGY: No, not really. Maybe for our next album. I'm really interested about coming to America for the first time. Just playing. Videos may be OK for other bands, but we're not interested in getting on MTV.

BSM: You went from the Damned, a major Punk band, to Tank, who are a metal band. Was that a difficult change?

ALGY: Punk & Metal - there's no change in the music, only the attitude & pose. BSM: So where do you fit with the attitude & pose?

ALGY: I was always being myself. Dressing the same as the way I am now.

BSM: The Pistols started before the Damned, but the Damned had the 'first' Punk single. Why?

PSYCHO/FALSE PROPHETS/FCC/SACRED DENIAL/SOCIAL DECAY/DOC MARTIN - SEASHORE, NJ - VFW
June 29, 85

Doc Martin played first. Not too bad, a 3 piece. Did a bunch of covers, + some originals like "Police Oppression". It had to be their first show, right? A very short set, but pretty good (oi! influenced). Next were Social Decay, and they were really fun hardcore, y'know. The singer didn't move much. Sacred Denial were next, and to say the truth, they've had better shows in their existence. Guido's guitar sounded like a motorcycle, and the sound was kind of fucked up. They played all their favorites like "Pissed at the world" and "Better way to Die". (Album review below). The PA, of course, sucked royally, but I've kind of expected that to happen. FCC were a pleasant surprise. They played some straightforward thrash and other interesting types of music, including an alternating ska/thrash version of "Wild thing" that really cranked. The "Banana Split Bunch There" they did was my fave. "Me, Myself + I" was good, too. I'm glad I picked up their demo tape at the show. Anyway, next was the show for me, The False Prophets. Believe me, I was not let down. Stephan + the crew were great, as usual. I've come to expect greatness from them. They performed all the old faves mentioned last issue, and even debuted a new song called "Shallow Earth" that was slow, long, and to tell the truth, fairly boring after a while. The crowd loved them until that song, when most people left the pit. Do bad for those who left. Gos Stepha was even better later in the set. They're getting a bit old, though. Psycho were next, and they were ok, churning out decent hardcore at a blistering pace. Many people I've spoken to describe them as sexist, but I didn't catch that at the show. Mega, the vocalist was a good frontman. I missed the last band or 2 because my ride was going back to NY. Even though they were metal, I'm sorry I missed them. One guy got arrested on \$600 bail, one on \$32 bail (which we raised. Hooray for unity), and people got hassled, but overall it was a good show. Hi Laure + Dave. Love, Mike


