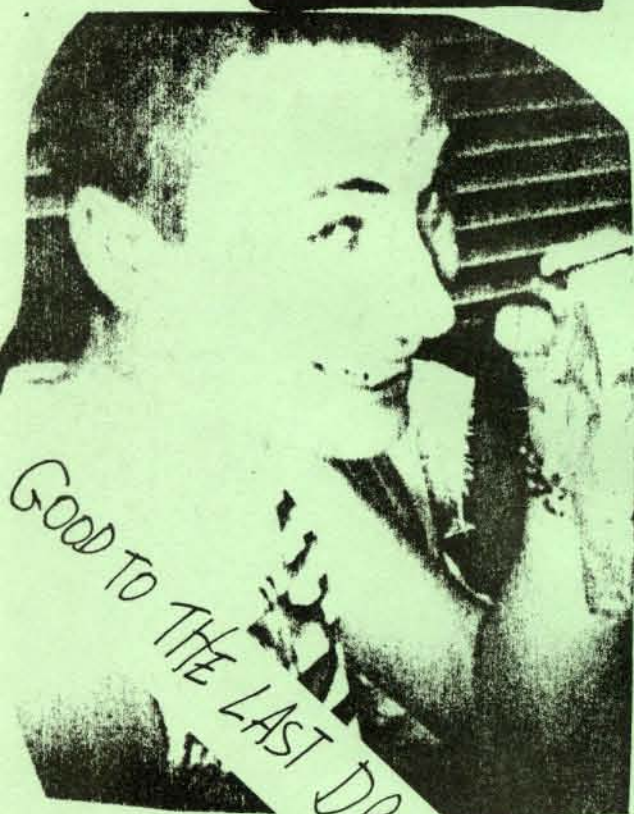

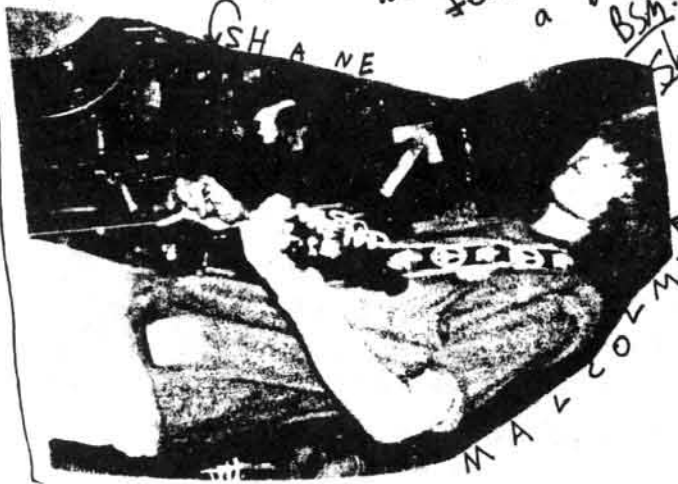

A new club has been born on 22nd Street, and we'll have more info later.

Why, I bet your asking is Mike reviewing the new C.O.C. album with D.R.I. z well, Dimwit, I'll tell you. In these 2 records, I see a large amount of similarities. First of all, it seems both bands signed onto a larger independent label (Death Records, a bit off Metal-Blade Records), and it has changed them drastically. Sure, D.R.I. keep some of their speed, but it's more spread out than the Dirty Rotten EP or LP, or even the 7", VIOLENT PACIFICATION. Something smells fishy around here if you ask me. The COC album has a lot of fuckin' problems with it. Of course I'm not expecting the record to compare with the live show, but it could try! This band sounds more like Carnivore than the COC I've seen live 3 times recently. What happened to these 2 bands? Reed's (COC) vocals aren't very good either. And the record has only 10 songs (their last album had 20!). D.R.I. has 27 songs, totaling 33 minutes, but isn't as good as they once were. We'll have COC pictures + an interview next issue, so hang on babies. D.R.I. + COC both have color covers, on slick paper + much cleaner (more metal sounding) production. Maybe they're growing up too quickly. The masturbating guitar solos are getting annoying.
